

Whistler Winter Activity Options

Creating memories to last a lifetime, Whistler's transformation into a winter wonderland is nothing short of magical. Blankets of snow wrap the peaks and valleys making way for endless activities. Exhilarating winter adventure awaits you, all within steps of the doors at the Fairmont Chateau Whistler.

The following list includes most of the activity options available. Simply let us know what we can arrange for you.

Cross Country Skiing - 1 to 6 hours

Lost Lake Park, the Fairmont Chateau Whistler Golf Course and the Nicklaus North Golf Course are connected by miles of track set skate and classic cross-country ski trails. Equipment rentals can easily be arranged and classic and skate ski lessons are available every day. For a unique dinner adventure, follow the lit trails right to the doors of The Chalet at the Fairmont Chateau Whistler, kick off your skis and sit down to a gourmet 3-course fondue dinner.

Dogsledding - 2.5 hours

Enjoy a wilderness ride with the dog breed that has dutifully served mankind for centuries. Suitable for two people per sled plus the Musher, tours run four times per day. This activity sells out early so please provide plenty of advance notice if your heart is set on a dog sled tour.

Downhill Skiing and Snowboarding - Up to 7 hours

Offering more than 8,100 acres of skiable terrain, Whistler and Blackcomb Mountains offer a 5280-foot vertical rise and provide spectacular views and adventure along the Coast Mountain Range. Lifts operate daily from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm and lessons can be arranged for half (3-hour) or full (6-hour) day programs. Whistler Kids - the full-day childcare and lesson program is available 8:30 am to 3:30 pm. For your convenience, equipment rentals and lift tickets can be arranged in our Mountain Adventure Centre or in advance through the Concierge Desk.

Fishing - 5 to 9 hours

Explore Whistler's backcountry lakes and rivers. Half day (5-hour) and full day (9-hour) tours expose you to the best



fishing locations where your experienced local fishing guides will teach you to fly fish or spin cast for trout. During the salmon runs, steel head spawn into surrounding rivers. Tours include everything you need, except your fishing license, which can be easily arranged.

Horse Drawn Sleigh Rides - 30 minutes to 1 hour

Nostalgic with the sounds of sleigh bells, Clydesdale-Percheron horses glide your sleigh effortlessly for a 30-minute tour from The Chalet at the Fairmont Chateau Whistler Golf Course through the serene, snow-covered valley. To further enchant your evening, reserve a table in The Chalet. A gourmet three-course fondue dinner includes cheese fondue, beef tenderloin, prawns and salmon plus dessert. A truly unique dinner adventure!

Helicopter Sightseeing

See the birds-eye view of Whistler Valley and the surrounding area from the comfort of a helicopter. A variety of tours are available ranging from 20 to 45 minutes.

Helicopter Skiing/Snowboarding

There is nothing like the thrill of carving up the fresh powder in the high alpine with your fully guided group. Suitable for intermediate and advanced riders.

Ice Skating - 1 to 3 hours

Meadow Park Sport Center, only a ten-minute drive from the Fairmont Chateau Whistler, offers public skating and themed skating evenings. Schedules change daily so please contact the Concierge Desk for complete details.

Snowmobile Tours- 1.5 to 4 hours

A variety of guided tours tailored to all skill levels will take you on a memorable backcountry adventure. Daytime or evening tours are available, some including meals. All clothing and equipment are provided. One or two people per snowmobile can be reserved. For your convenience, Outdoor Adventures Whistler's operation desk is located on the lower lobby level, beside the Mountain Adventure Centre Ski Valet and Rental Shop.

Snowshoeing - 1 hour to all day

Whether an experienced or first-time snowshoer, friendly, professional guides will take you on an unforgettable tour through the woods. If you prefer to go on your own, we will be happy to arrange rental equipment and provide a trail map. For an unforgettable Whistler experience, sign up for a nightly stroll at 6:00 pm. This snowshoe tour, which runs through the forest and is guided by the light of the moon and starry sky, ends at the doors of The Chalet. Located at the Fairmont Chateau Whistler Golf Course, The Chalet greets you with a crackling log fire and a delicious 3-course fondue dinner. Live entertainment makes your evening complete.

Spa - 1 hour to all day

Choose from a variety of massage therapy, bodywork, or aesthetic treatments in the Vida Wellness Spa at The Fairmont Chateau Whistler.

Tennis - 1 to 3 hours

Whistler's indoor tennis and racquet center is located minutes away from the Fairmont Chateau Whistler. See the Concierge Desk to book courts.

Vancouver Day Trip - 10 to 11 hours

Tours departs the Fairmont Chateau Whistler at 8:00 am and return at 6:30 pm. On route to Vancouver, enjoy views of spectacular waterfalls and scenery. While in Vancouver, choose from several stopover points for shopping and sightseeing.

TreeTrek Ecotours – 1.5 hours

A spectacular network of suspension bridges, boardwalks and trails take you from the forest floor to the upper reaches of the forest canopy. Touch the tips of 10-storey high trees and search for the forest floor through the branches. Douglas fir, Western Red Cedar, Western Hemlock and other trees host you on your exploration.

Whistler/Blackcomb Tube Park - 1 hour to all day

Located at Base Two on Blackcomb Mountain, the Coca-Cola Tube Park offers great fun for the young and young at heart. No skill or equipment required – just a sense of adventure and a desire for excitement!

Zip Line Tours- 2-3 hours

Ride on a series of zipline cables, some as long as 2000 feet and 200 feet above the forest floor. Joined together by bridges, aerial stairways and ground-based trails, your adventure guide explores the beautiful temperate rain forest in the mountains of Whistler on this adrenalin-fueled outing.
