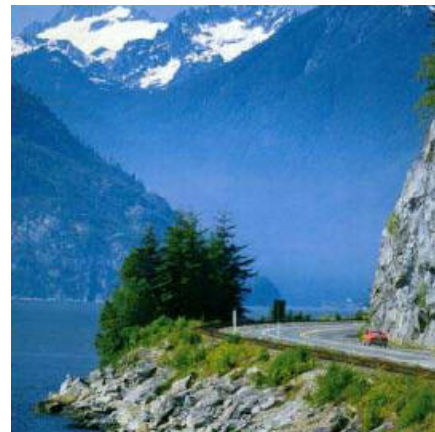


Driving Directions from Vancouver to Whistler

Dramatically situated where the Pacific Ocean meets the Coast Mountains, Vancouver, British Columbia is a remarkable gateway for your journey to Whistler.

Your adventure begins where the water and mountains meet. This is a journey as unforgettable as the destination.

Breathtaking views of rugged coastlines, towering green forests and soaring mountain summits. Marvel at the natural beauty on the journey to Whistler as you travel two hours north of Vancouver along the stunning Sea-to-Sky Highway (Highway 99).



FROM VANCOUVER INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT:

- To exit the airport, follow the signs to Grant McConachie Way, Vancouver & City Center.
- Proceed over the Arthur Laing Bridge, keep right and follow the signs to Granville Street and City Center.
- Proceed along Granville Street (approx. 8km) and cross over the Granville Street Bridge.
- Take the Seymour exit off Granville Bridge and follow Seymour Street, 7 blocks to Georgia Street and turn left (west).
- Continue with directions “from downtown Vancouver” as listed below or “bypass downtown Vancouver”

FROM DOWNTOWN VANCOUVER:

- Head west along Georgia Street approximately 12 blocks to Stanley Park, then through Stanley Park and onto the Lion’s Gate Bridge.
- As you leave the bridge, follow the signs for West Vancouver.
- You will find yourself on Marine Drive and at the first traffic light turn right onto Taylor Way.
- At the second traffic light, take the left lane and follow the signs to Horseshoe Bay, Squamish, and Whistler. This will take you along Highway 99 North, which is also Highway 1 West.
- Continue North along Highway 99 to Whistler Village. This will take about 1.5 hours.

TO BYPASS DOWNTOWN VANCOUVER:

- Proceed over the Arthur Laing Bridge and follow the sign to South West Marine Drive.
- Continue along South West Marine Drive, (which turns into Marine Way) make a left turn on Boundary Road and continue along Boundary.
- Be sure to stay in the left-hand lane, pass through Grandview Hwy and turn left onto Highway 1.
- Cross over the 2nd Narrows Bridge and the highway automatically turns in Highway 99.
- Continue North along Highway 99 to Whistler Village. This will take about 1.5 hours.

ONCE YOU’VE REACHED THE WHISTLER AREA:

- Proceed through the first 5 traffic lights (Function Junction, Bayshores, Creekside, Blueberry, Village) and turn right at the sixth traffic light onto Lorimer Road.
- Follow Lorimer Road through the traffic light to the Upper Village, until you reach the four way stop sign at Blackcomb Way.
- Turn right onto Blackcomb Way, and almost immediately you will see the Fairmont Chateau Whistler sign at the foot of Chateau Boulevard on your left hand side.
