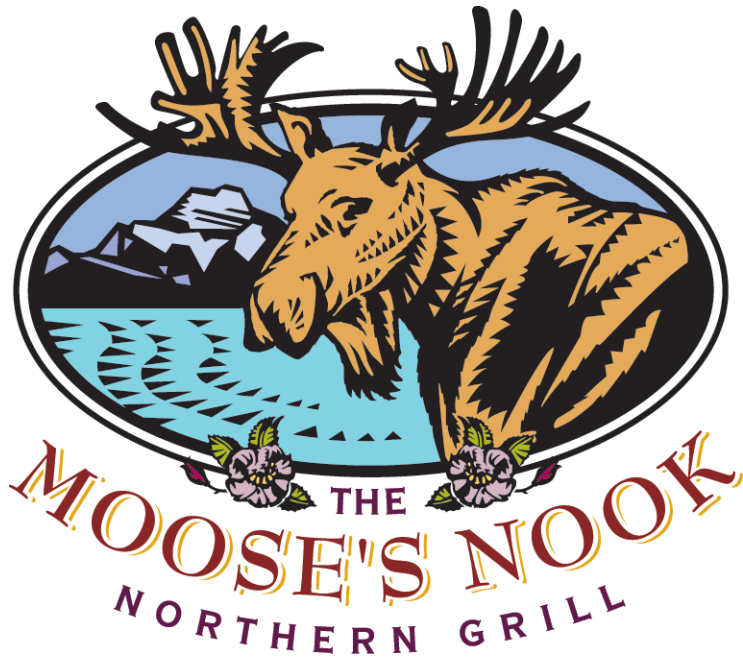

CANADIAN WINE REGIONS

BRITISH COLUMBIA- OKANAGAN VALLEY

Located between the Coastal and Monashee Mountain Ranges of British Columbia and spanning 250kms from Vernon to the Washington border along a chain of lakes, most notably Lake Okanagan. Wines of the Okanagan Valley are consistently ranked among the world's best at international competitions, and account for over 80% of BC's total area under vine. This is a fast-changing landscape of current, changing and emerging sub-regions. The first vines of British Columbia were planted in the sub-region of Kelowna in 1859, and boasts Canada's oldest continually operating winery, Calona Vineyard (est. 1931). The Naramata Bench has ideal conditions for growing aromatic Pinot Gris and Viognier as well as Bordeaux grape varieties, thanks to its' close proximity to Lake Okanagan, aspect of its' slopes and long growing seasons featuring frost free autumn months. Black Sage/Osyoos is officially Canada's hottest area. Located on the most southern tip of the Okanagan, encompassing the northern end of the Sonora desert and stretching to the US border. Its' deep, sandy soils and hot, sunny growing season produces many of Canada's finest Bordeaux blends.

ONTARIO

The Niagara Peninsula is the largest planted viticultural area in Canada with two distinct weather-moderating features that create unique micro-climates throughout the region: Lake Ontario and the Niagara Escarpment. Lake Ontario assists in keeping the immediate area cool in hot summer months and warmer in the winter, while the escarpment's north facing cliff formations prevent cold air from settling and offers protection from prevailing winds. In addition to the up-and-coming sub regions of Lincoln Lakeshore and Vinemount Ridge, there are two regional-appellations: Niagara-on-the-lake and the Niagara Escarpment.

Niagara-on-the-Lake is located below the crest of the escarpment, stretching to the Niagara River and shores of Lake Ontario and includes the sub-appellations of: Niagara River, Niagara Lakeshore, St David's Bench and Four Mile Creek. All share the common attributes of proximity to the lake, river and escarpment although they are also unique unto themselves with varying soil composition, elevation and micro-climate. Four Mile Creek is in the centre of this sub-region, a fertile plain found inland from the lake and just below the escarpment. Niagara River is a small strip of land with sandy soil running along the Niagara River and inland on gentle sloping hills. Niagara Lakeshore follows the shoreline of Lake Ontario. Its proximity to the lake moderates temperatures year round and is particularly supportive of later-ripening varieties. The gentle slopes of St David's Bench, located 10kms south of the shores of Lake Ontario, offers early spring warming and an abundance of precipitation.

The Niagara Escarpment is recognized by UNESCO as a World Biosphere Reserve, it is the most prominent topographical feature of southern Ontario. Its sub-appellations share the attributes of fossil-rich soils and dramatic topography along the forested escarpment ridge and are sheltered from prevailing south-westerly winds. The narrow plateau of Beamsville Bench begins from the cliffs of the escarpment running north. Most vineyards are located on steep slopes above the wooded ravines and along the slopes of numerous streams that bisect the area. Twenty Mile Bench is a double-bench formation offering high elevation and long sun exposure which extends daytime temps well into the evening. Short Hills Bench is the most easterly and inland sub-appellation, rising from the plain of the peninsula. It is comprised of undulating hills and valleys with excellent drainage and sun exposure throughout the year. Winter temperatures descend early here, benefitting the early harvest of Icewine.

Prince Edward County is Ontario's newest and most northern appellation was identified as a VQA appellation of origin in 2007. Situated south of Belleville, most vineyards are separated from the mainland and surrounded by the waters of Lake Ontario. The stony limestone soil allows for excellent drainage and acts as a sponge, forcing vines to grow deeper roots which in turn produces naturally smaller yields with concentrated flavours.
