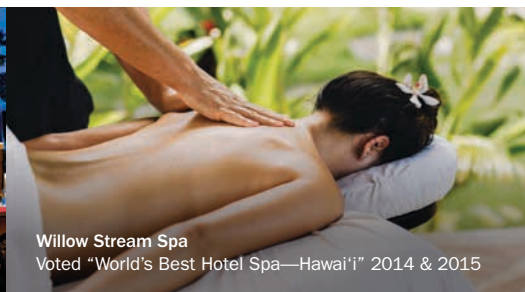

WATER SAFETY

For your safety, please follow all rules and regulations while enjoying the beach and pools. Warning flags for ocean conditions:

- A red flag indicates high surf, strong currents and/or dangerous shore breaks.
- A yellow flag signals jellyfish, man o'war or sea urchins are prevalent in the area.

Please familiarize yourself with the warning flags and signs. In the event you do not see any warning, contact a beach or pool attendant to confirm water conditions. Please note there are no lifeguards on duty at any time. To ensure the safety of our guests, we do not issue snorkel or boogie board equipment when flags are present.
