# The Rocky Mountain Heritage Reception

Travel Through Time Until The Turn of the Century! Lake Louise is famous for its beauty, and the unique history that has shaped it. Using décor, along with entertaining characters we bring the turn of the century to life!

### **DÉCOR**

#### **First Nations**

The first people who made use of the mountains and led others here were the local First Nations tribes. This vignette includes a painted door of a teepee to create the backdrop for authentic and colourful pieces: beautiful handcrafted bows, arrows, shields and spears.

#### **Explorers, Trappers & Traders**

This vignette represents the intrepid traveller's to first make their way through the mountain passes, such as the famous David Thompson. A small trapper's tent is surrounded with trees. Sitting in front is a fire pit circled with rocks. An enamelware pot is slung over the fire, with additional pots beside.

#### **Horse Outfitting**

Around this area is the backcountry gear for horseback riding. An antique saddle and collar, ropes and other gear sit amongst trees and rocks. The other items from camp, barrels, bottles and cookware fill in.

#### **Mountain Guiding in the Rockies**

A towering boulder, antique skis, snowshoes, ropes, and "Tyrolean" hats are a tribute to the first mountain guides in the area. Originally from Switzerland, these pioneers created the first forms of adventure tourism in the Lake Louise.
