2007 Eroica by Dr. Loosen Riesling, Columbia Valley

This aged Riesling delivers fresh mandarin, orange and lime aromas with subtle mineral and slate notes.

2008 Austral by Chateau Ste. Michelle, Columbia Valley

This Southern Rhone-style blend is made with Mourvedre, Grenache and Syrah. Jammy fruit, pepper, herbs and spices lead into a polished finish.

2007 Col Solare Red Blend, Columbia Valley

Why not. Treat yourself! Aromas of black cherry, currants, and blackberry blend with subtle notes of vanilla and milk chocolate. Tannins are rich and refined on the finish.

Biodynamic and Organic Wine Selections

Although biodynamic and organic wines fall into the same general category of alternative farming practices, the two are distinct.

Biodynamics is an organic sustainable farming system that is based on a series of lectures given by Austrian philosopher-scientist Rudolf Steiner in 1924. Key to biodynamics is considering the farm in its entirety as a living system. To this end biodynamic farms are supposed to be closed, self-sustaining systems. Steiner believed that fertilizers and pesticides were degrading the quality of food due to chemical substances and the spiritual shortcomings of chemical farming. Biodynamics in the simplest terms brings the attention to the soil or terroir rather than to the winemaker or winemaking techniques to shape a wine. These practices bring the soil “back to life,” and truly give wines the “soul” that allow for extra complexity and personality.

While biodynamic winemaking does have some unusual techniques such as burying cow horns with manure, or spraying the vineyard with ground quartz (silica) and harvesting by moon cycles, it remains one of the more exciting trends in the wine world today.

At its most basic level, organic wine is made from grapes that have been grown without the use of chemical fertilizers, pesticides, fungicides and herbicides. Winemaking techniques should be organic as well; little or no manipulation of wines by reverse osmosis, excessive filtration, or flavor additives (such as oak chips). Many organic winemakers also prefer wild yeasts for fermentation.

You will notice two asterisks (**) after certain wines on our list denoting wineries that practice biodynamic farming techniques. Wines with one asterisk (*) represent wines with organic farming and grape growing. We believe these wine practices are important and make a difference in the quality of the wines. It allows you to support a winery that chooses to grow grapes “naturally” and without the use of herbicides and unnecessary chemicals. We invite you to try one of these wines as an alternative and see if you can taste the difference.
