



ACCESSIBLE GUESTROOMS AT THE FAIRMONT WATERFRONT

GUESTROOMS:

The Fairmont Waterfront has 12 guest rooms designed to accommodate a wheelchair or scooter:

- 6 Fairmont Rooms - 2 with one King, 4 with two Doubles
- 4 Portside Deluxe - 2 with one King, 2 with two Doubles
- 1 Waterfront Deluxe - 1 with one Queen
- 1 Fairmont Gold Harbour view room – 1 with one King Bed

These rooms are equipped with:

- Adjustable shower heads
- Grab bars on the bath tub wall and adjacent to the toilet
- Easily accessible electrical switches and outlets
- Larger washroom area, bathroom door which swings outward
- Lowered coat hanger behind bathroom door
- Lower "peep" holes on the hotel room door
- There are visual and audible alarms and fire refuge areas on each floor for wheelchair users.
- Please Note: There are no roll in showers or lowered sinks.

On Request: raised toilet seats, tub chairs, transfer benches, walker or wheelchair.

Public Area Access: The lobby area, public washrooms, meeting rooms and Herons Restaurant and lounge all offer easy, unobstructed access. The Hotel main entrance is covered to protect guests from inclement weather and has a handicapped passenger loading zone. The parking area offers 9 Accessible parking spaces.

All areas of the Health Club are wheelchair accessible except for the steam room, which is too small to allow wheelchairs. There is no lift for the pool but with assistance it is accessible.

Hearing Impaired Guest Amenities on Request:

- Closed caption decoding equipment
- Telephone compatible with hearing aids
- T.D.D phones - The hotel can arrange for the rental of one of these phones through the Western Institute for the Deaf at a cost of \$ 30.00 CAD per week.
- There are visual emergency alarms.
