






CEREMONY & RECEPTION SPACES

Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise offers a selection of indoor and outdoor ceremony spaces, as well as reception halls. Each unique location offers a picturesque backdrop for your celebration. Room capacities vary depending on the set-up requirements for your function.

Ceremony set-up includes chairs and a signing desk, while reception and dinner set-up includes tables, chairs, table linens, china, glassware and signature silver flatware. If you choose to host your ceremony in the same space as your reception, please allow for three hours of set up time in between your ceremony and reception. This also applies if your weather back-up ceremony location is the same as your reception location.

Please note a wedding reception must be reserved to book a wedding ceremony.



SUNROOM

For weddings of 50-75 guests, the Sunroom is available during the months of July, August and September, from Monday to Friday. This Lakeview room is a rotunda room located inside the Victoria Ballroom; it is required to walk through the ballroom to access the space. This room is perfect for smaller parties wishing to have a beautiful view of the lake for their wedding ceremony and dinner and also provides you with the Victoria Terrace for your cocktail reception. The Sunroom is not available to be booked on its own, outside the time frame specified without booking the Victoria Ballroom in addition.

VICTORIA BALLROOM

The architecturally stunning Victoria Foyer or Sun Room provide a beautiful cocktail reception space for the time between the ceremony and dinner.

Music must be turned down at 10:00 PM and must be switched off at 11:00 PM.



Built in 2004, the elegant and contemporary Mount Temple Ballroom provides a state-of-the-art facility for the wedding of your dreams. Although the space does not have windows, the adjacent Alpine Gallery and Heritage Hall reception areas features beautiful views through double storey stained glass windows. The enclosed main space allows for semi-sound proofing so that events can continue with music and dancing until 2:00 AM.

BOOKING PROCESS

During the initial inquiry stage, you will be working with our Wedding and Catering Manager or Conference Services Coordinator. Our Wedding team will be happy to answer any questions, discuss availability, and confirm site appointments for you to view the venue. We would be delighted to host your special day with us in the Canadian Rocky Mountains. The next step towards booking is signing a Wedding Agreement with the hotel. Please contact the Wedding and Catering Manager to move forward with your booking. Once you receive the Wedding Agreement, you will have one week to review it with your fiancé and family. When you return the agreement, a non-refundable deposit is due.

Upon receipt of the signed contract and deposit, you will be assigned one of our Conference Services Managers. This person will be your key contact that will handle the final details of your event. They will contact you to introduce him/herself and to discuss the planning process and timeline that will ensure a successful event.

Typically we start the pre-planning process six months prior to the wedding, however please feel free to contact your Conference Services Manager. if you have any questions prior to then.

BOOKING PROCESS

Continued

You will receive a Wedding Questionnaire which will help plan your special day with us. The wedding questionnaire is due back to the hotel 60 days before the wedding, or sooner. Once the questionnaire is completed, your hotel contact will setup a meeting with you to review the information together. We recommend a menu tasting and initial pre-planning hotel visit six months before the wedding. Your next steps will include hiring a Wedding Planner, Florist, Photographer and Marriage Commissioner, as vendors can sometimes book up more than a year in advance.

CHOICE OF PRE-SELECTED ENTRÉES

For a tableside selection of courses, please allow for a set first course of soup, salad or appetizer before a choice of two second courses, three entrées, and two desserts. If you would like to build your own plated dinner menu, please note that a surcharge will be applied for tableside selection menus.



PRICING & ESTIMATES

Menus and wine selections must be confirmed within 30 days of your wedding day. Once your final menu and beverage requirements have been confirmed, your Wedding Specialist will prepare an estimate for your wedding.

For your initial budgeting purposes please anticipate the following:

- One bottle of wine (750 ml) serves five glasses
- One bottle of sparkling wine or champagne serves six champagne flutes
- Estimate a minimum of 1/2 bottle of wine per person for dinner and 1/3 of a bottle per person for lunch
- Estimate a minimum of six pieces of hors d'oeuvres per person, based on a one hour reception before main meal
- Estimate two drinks per person for the first hour of a reception, one drink per hour for each hour after that
- Anticipate 20-30 minutes for each course to be served, for an enjoyable dinner service



It is the policy of Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise to serve alcoholic beverages in a reasonable and professional manner at all times. We will adhere to all applicable laws and regulations as they pertain to the service of alcohol to under age or intoxicated persons. The hours of alcoholic beverage service at the Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise are 10:00 AM to 2:00 AM Monday through Sunday and holidays. Under no circumstances are guests allowed to leave the function space with an alcoholic beverage as the hotel corridors are not licensed by the Alberta Gaming & Liquor Commission.







ALBERTA MARRIAGE LAWS

Prior to the ceremony, couples must obtain an Alberta Marriage License from a registry in the province of Alberta. The license is valid for three months from the date of issue.

OBTAINING AN ALBERTA MARRIAGE LICENSE

The Bride and Groom must provide the following information:

- Proof of identification
- Full name of father, birth place of father
- Maiden and full name of mother, birth place of mother
- If divorced, Decree Absolute
- If widowed, Death Certificate of former spouse

NOTE: There is no Marriage License issuing office in Lake Louise. Couples from out of province may arrange their Alberta Marriage License in advance through the Banff Bureau.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Two witnesses of at least 18 years of age are required for the ceremony. It is not necessary that the witnesses have prior knowledge of the couple being married. The Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise is able to provide witnesses at a cost of \$100 per witness for their services. Civil marriage ceremonies can be conducted at any location.

Upon the granting of Royal Assent to the federal Civil Marriage Act, same-sex marriage is legal in Alberta as of July 20, 2005.

Wedding Commissioners are appointed by the Alberta Government but are not salaried employees and are not subsidized. Rates may vary between Wedding Commissioners. Blood tests and waiting periods are not required for marriage in Alberta.



THE FINE PRINT

The Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise will only host wedding ceremonies if they are accompanied by a food and beverage function. All function rooms used for dinner events have a minimum food and beverage revenue requirement (this minimum includes all food and beverage consumed including your dinner menu, wine and bar service). Your food and beverage actual spending is subject to a surcharge of 20% and 5% GST. If you do not meet the food and beverage minimum requirement, the difference between your actual spending and the minimum will be charged as a rental, subject to 5% GST.

AUDIO VISUAL CONSIDERATIONS

Audio visual equipment (podium, microphone, lapel microphone, sound systems), can be supplied by our in-house vendor PSAV Presentation Services.

CEREMONY REHEARSAL

A service charge of \$85.00 + GST applies for the one hour room rental, including the set up. The hotel will set up the front row, aisle chairs and registry signing desk as they will be set for your wedding.

We will do our best to accommodate requests to hold your ceremony rehearsal in the same room that your wedding ceremony is booked in, however, we are unable to guarantee space availability, time and location of your ceremony rehearsal until two weeks prior.

OTHER CEREMONY SPECIAL NOTES

Kindly note that tossing of rose petals is allowed as long as they are cleaned up after the ceremony, otherwise a \$100 clean-up fee will apply. The following items are not permitted: confetti, birdseed, rice, live butterfly or dove release.

OUTDOOR CEREMONIES

The outdoor ceremony includes an indoor weather alternative location which is included in the rental fee. Location of an indoor weather alternative is at the hotel's discretion and subject to change based on availability. The earliest time for an outdoor ceremony is 11:00 AM. Please allow a minimum of one hour for ceremony set-up. The weather call for an outdoor ceremony will be made with your Wedding Specialist on the day of the ceremony: at 8:00 AM for morning ceremonies and 11:00 AM for afternoon ceremonies, based on weather conditions. Please note that once a weather call is made, the ceremony plans cannot be changed.

WINTER WEDDINGS

Winter outdoor weddings will be subject to an additional snow shoveling charge and weather-dependent safety assessments.

PARKING & TRAFFIC

Parking is available in the public parking lot (adjacent to the hotel) free of charge on a first-come first-serve basis. We kindly reserve hotel parking for registered in-house guests.

Since the Lake Louise area experiences a high volume of day visitors in the summer months and special event weekends, we highly recommend allowing ample time for guests to arrive prior to the ceremony. Your Wedding Specialist is available to discuss alternative transportation options.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Please note that our cancellation policies require nonrefundable payment of total anticipated revenue figures as per your contract based on the following timeline:

- 0 to 90 days prior to wedding date: 100%
- 91 to 180 days prior to wedding date: 90%
- 181 to 365 days prior to wedding date: 80%
- 366 days or more prior to wedding date: 70%

NOISE POLICY

Please note that the hotel reserves the right to control the volume of music at all times if guest complaints are registered. Please consult your Wedding Specialist for details on music policy.

MUSIC CHARGES

All functions with music other than our hotel's default background music will be subject to the following charges from SOCAN and RE:SOUND. Please note that these are two distinct organizations that represent different groups and rights. As such, fees for both organizations will be charged.

Its role is to license the public performance of music in return for performing rights fees. It is the responsibility of the Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise to collect these fees on behalf of SOCAN for groups having functions with music in the hotel.

SOCAN fee charges shall apply to each function with music as per the following tariff No. 8 schedule:
