The 120 beats to the minute quickly established itself as the musical signature of New York's embryonic disco culture, becoming a gateway to escapism and changing lives forever.

ALL MIXED UP 8

Waves of disco tracks were being created by the New York studios and producers were engineering this music to work for the dance floor. In the 1970s the remix was taking away elements, creating grooves where there might not have been, and accenting certain parts. New producers emerged to serve the disco explosion, but the superstar of the remix was New York producer Tom Moulton – specialising in turning soul music into pure disco. SOUNDS OF THE UNDERGROUND

Robert Williams was a New York promotor who decided to bring some New York flair to the windy city of Chicago, opening the doors to The Warehouse in 1977. His eclectic cocktail of disco, funk & European electronica created the coolest underground dance music, and a nickname soon attached itself – House!

The Roland 808 drum machine was the perfect piece of kit to get the creative juices flowing of the novice producers of Chicago house scene. The house music of Chicago was born, and so was the future of dance music!

THE BELLEVILLE THREE 8

Influenced by Kraftwerk's Teutonic electro-pop and Alvin Toffler's concept of "techno rebels," a clique of deejay-producers – Derrick May, Juan Atkins, and Kevin Saunderson – started making their own music, influenced by the gritty and industrial back drop of their home city of Detroit. With its infectious basslines it was no surprise that by the late 80s techno had blown up with tracks such as "Strings of Life" and "Good Life", being played around Europe's dancefloors.

House would have remained an underground dance moment if it was not for a chance discovery by a young British record scout, Pete Tong. One day he opened a box of at one of his favourite record stores in London and was astounded by its "embarrassment of riches"; unearthing records from the newly emerging house sound of Chicago, and quickly realised he was onto something. In 1986, Tong organised a compilation album, The House Sound of Chicago, Vol. 1, the first British release to gather and expose this genre.

BALEARIC BEATS 8

Alfredo Fiorito was the ground-breaking 80s resident at the iconic Amnesia, Ibiza. His ethos was hailed a phenomenon amongst music lovers and club goers, inspiring a new generation of DJs that would take the dance world by storm in the years to come.

LOVE SAVES THE DAY 8

David Mancuso revolutionized night life in New York (and eventually the world) by hosting the first ever underground party, "Love Says the Day", at his downtown loft on Valentine's Day 1970. Every Saturday over the next decade his top-of-the-line sound system delivered an eclectic musical mix to his guests, becoming a near religious-rite for the city's underground. His only request was that each song had soul, rhythm, and imparted words of hope, redemption, or pride.
