

The Club at the Claremont Temporary Tennis Rules

- 1. Do not play if you are ill or are showing symptoms of any kind. Please wash hands or sanitize them prior to arrival. Players assume all risks, including exposure to COVID 19, with the understanding they have waived all rights under the terms of the membership agreement.
- 2. Current Alameda County Health Department (ACHD) May 18th mandates specify that only singles may be played at this time. All players must bring their tennis balls and use two separate marked sets, handling only their own tennis balls.
- 3. Courts can be reserved from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM Monday-Friday and 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM on weekends by calling (510) 549-8517 during this same time period.
- 4. Court reservations may be made up to 48 hours in advance at this time, subject to change. As a courtesy to others, please cancel reservations in advance so that we can extend play to others.
- 5. All members must have a reservation ahead of time or entry cannot be granted. Check in will occur at Club front door with one party at a time for check in, practicing social distancing of 6 feet or more. Members play only permitted at this time. No outside guests at this time.
- 6. Players must arrive at the Club reception with masks on and must wear masks when entering and leaving the courts.

 No masks required when ball is in play. Please don masks upon exiting the courts to return to your car. Please exit the property via the lower turnstile, avoiding hand contact.
- 7. Please plan to arrive ten minute before reservation time for check in. You must go directly to your court and allow social distancing when moving through courts. You must exit courts promptly through the turnstile. No gathering or socializing will be permitted on or around courts.
- 8. Players must provide their own balls; all balls must be removed from the courts when play is over. Do not leave any balls on court, including placing them in the trash can. Provide proper distancing if ball comes cross court.
- For health and safety please bring your own towels, water, tennis balls and hand sanitizer for courtside use. Club towels will not be provided at this time. All tennis balls must be removed when you depart.
- 10. There will be a ½ hour interval between court reservations, time for players to exit and enter while utilizing social distancing and to permit staff to sanitize all touch points.
- 11. No ball machine reservations or use will be permitted during at this time.
- 12. There will be no access to the Clubhouse facilities. Toilet and hand wash facilities are limited to the port-a-potty located by court 8. Please practice strict hygiene.
- 13. Tennis lessons will begin when ACHD permits lessons.
- 14. These temporary rules are subject to change.
